‘Swords of Iron’: 2023 Israel-Hamas War – No. 4

Members of the Association and Family of the Signal & Cyber Corps,

During the last eight weeks, Israel is in the midst of the 'Iron Swords' war, a complex and tough war, that was imposed on us in all fronts. We paid a horrible price of murdered, fallen, injured, kidnapped and absent people, civilians and soldiers. Our forces are fighting with valor and determination to achieve victory, release the hostages and return security and prosperity to our country.

Soldiers and commanders of the Signal & Cyber Corps, reservists and regulars, take part in the fighting from the first moment, and unfortunately have already paid a heavy price of losing commanding officers and soldiers, both men and women, and more families have joined the circle of bereft families of the Corps. Our association will commemorate them forever. Soldiers from Yehud-Monoson who fell in this battle will be commemorated in the Memorial Hall for the Fallen Soldiers of Yehud.

As mentioned in our former letters, the association has decided to increase its activity, and extend more funds for the bereaved families, and for raising the morale of all the Signal & Cyber Corps units active in all fronts. So far, we have distributed 2,400 personal kits to soldiers (1,400 for men and 1,000 for women), and hundreds of portable power banks for cellphones and coffee sets. **The thanks and appreciation we received from the soldiers were touching.** Last week we were busy purchasing 1,400 sets of winter gear, the first batch (including hats and mittens, thermal shirts and socks, undershirts and t-shirts, underpants and wipes), to be distributed during this week. The kits were packed by the Association, assisted by volunteers and high school students.

We wish to emphasize that extensive activities take place at the Association's premises. About 300 soldiers and candidates for military service and other security services, such as Prison Service and Intelligence, as well as civilians, take part in courses of the Computers Professional School. The Signals and Telematics School (Bahad 7) continues with heritage tours and formal activities of the Officers' courses and other Advanced Courses at the Association's Site.

We wish to thank everyone who has assisted us until now in our efforts related to these activities in this period of emergency. Our warm thanks to all donors. The donations have grown, but unfortunately they don't keep up with the growing expenditure to help our soldiers in the approaching winter.

Members of the Association and members of the Signal & Cyber Corps family, our fund raising continues, and we implore you to continue to support the soldiers in all the units of the Signal & Cyber Corps on all fronts. Please help us with your personal donation and engage more members to donate. We will be very grateful for your generous cooperation!

We hope you will continue to support us in view of the long and harsh fighting which is expected to continue on various fronts. We thank you in advance for your contributions!

We, the members of the Association for the Commemoration of the Fallen Soldiers of the Signal Corps, bend our heads and express our condolences for the fallen and the murdered, and wish full recovery for all wounded, and pray for the return of the hostages, abducted victims and missing.
