'Iron Swords' – Letter No. 5

My dear ones, members of the association and the family of the IDF Signal Corps throughout the ages,

As of October 7, 2023, the State of Israel is engaged in the 'Iron Sword's war, a complex and difficult war that has been forced upon us on all fronts. We paid a heavy price of being murdered, fallen, wounded, kidnapped and missing. Our forces are fighting fiercely and resolutely to achieve victory, to return the abductees, to return the evacuees to their homes, and for the security and prosperity of our country.

The Communications and ICT Corps, with its soldiers and commanders, regular and reserve, has been participating in the combat effort since its inception, and unfortunately has so far paid a heavy price in loss of life and wounded. Despite the terrible pain, the IDF and the ICT Corps are ready to fight until victory and the return of the hostages.

As noted in previous letters, since the beginning of the war, the association has joined the effort and expanded its activities by allocating considerable resources and funds (about NIS 450,000) to raise morale and meet the needs of soldiers in the Signal and ICT Corps units deployed in the combat sectors, from the battalion communications department level to the General Staff communications units, by allocating personal gift kits of summer and winter equipment and team kits. Over the past month, 1,000 softshell jackets were distributed. **The thanks from the field are many and very moving.**

We would like to thank everyone who has volunteered to assist and support the efforts of the association derived from the emergency. Recently, with the help of dear friends of the organization, we have also received a number of significant donations from the United States, France and the Christian Embassy in Israel. Some of these donors came to Israel, visited the association and gave personal kits and 'Softshells' to the units. **A warm thank you to all donors from Israel and abroad.**

In the current year, the organization intends to expand its activities even further, helping and supporting bereaved families in need, awarding scholarships to those who excelled in the Iron Swords War, participating in the Iron Swords Heritage Documentation Project, holding a conference honoring reservists who participated in the war, and more.

It is important to note that in addition to the activity mentioned, the organization's site in Yehud-Monosson is "alive and breathing" and extensive activity is carried out by IDF assessment centers for lieutenant colonels, heritage events and activities of various civilian elements. In addition, Bahad 7 continues to conduct the tours, ceremonies and ceremonies of various courses, officers' courses and senior courses.

We once again appeal to the members of the association and the family of the Signal and ICT Corps throughout the generations: Get under the stretcher and help us with the donation journey. **We ask you to continue to strengthen and support** our soldiers and bereaved families from the Communications and ICT Corps and the ICT and Cyber Defense Division, as long as necessary, in the long and difficult war that awaits us in the various sectors. Come join the

organization as a member and make your personal contribution, recruit additional members in Israel and abroad, and add new members to the organization.

This is essential so that we can continue to carry out the sacred activity for which we have been entrusted, to maintain the commemoration, to pass on the legacy of the corps and the fallen, and to support our soldiers on the front and in the home front. Our thanks are given to you in advance!

We, the members of the Association for the Commemoration of the Fallen of the Signal and ICT Corps, bow our heads and express our condolences for the fallen and murdered and hope for the speedy recovery of the wounded, the speedy return of the abductees and the safe return of our soldiers.

Together we will win! Am Yisrael Chai!
